What is myGAP?

A certification scheme developed according to Malaysia Standard MS 1784 for the crop sector, to extend recognition to farm practicing Good Agricultural Practice (GAP) following an environmental-friendly concept and preservation of welfare and safety of workers, in order to produce quality and safe produce suitable for consumption.

Why should I buy
the agricultural product
that has myGAP logo?

1 The produce is safe, quality and suitable for consumption

2 The farm is recognized by Department of Agriculture Malaysia


3 The farm implement Good Agricultural Practice

Practice integrated Pest Management (IPM) with biological, mechanical, physical, cultural, quarantine control and minimal use of chemicals.

4 Free from prohibited sewage and waste



myGAP CERTIFICATION PROCESS



The Validation Period of myGAP CERTIFICATION

Renewal application must be submitted 6 months before the expiry period



REVOCATION of Certificate

myGAP certification may be withdrawn based on the following reasons:

- 1 Failure to renew the certificate after the expiry date
- 2 The farm is found to be in non-compliance with the specified conditions while still in the validity period
- 3 Misuse of the certificate and logo in any way



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

What is myGAP?

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Who Can PARTICIPATE IN myGAP?

A) Categories of applicants are as follows:

- 1 Individual
- 2 Private Company
- 3 Agencies/ Statutory Bodies




B) The applicant has to ensure the following:

- 1 Operation on legally valid land
- 2 Farms has been planted and producing yield
- 3 The farm produce is meant for the domestic or export market



What is the EVALUATION CRITERIA?

Applicant must pass all the three requirements below:

-  Site Inspection
-  Water and harvest sample for pesticide residues, heavy metals and bacterial analysis
-  Farm verification/ practices

SERVICE CHARGES

Enrolment in the scheme is voluntary and service is given FREE to participants for certification purposes.

What are the ADVANTAGES OF CERTIFICATION?

- 1 Results in quality agricultural produce which are safe for consumption since the content of pesticides residue in the produce are at permissible
- 2 Reduces pollution of the environment
- 3 Gives priority to the integrated pest control approach
- 4 Reduces the use of pesticides
- 5 Assures the safety and the welfare of farm workers
- 6 Produces better quality harvest
- 7 Agricultural produce is easily recognizable and can compete in the domestic and the international markets
- 8 Supports the developments of National Agricultural Industry which is sustainable and environmental friendly
- 9 The myGAP logo on the product label assures consumers on the safety of the product
